The Mobile Application, which was developed within the scope of the project and is one of the outputs of the project, includes various activity plans prepared in 6 languages (Turkish, English, Lithuanian, Danish, Croatian, Macedonian), covering 4 basic courses (Mathematics, Literacy, Science, Social Studies).

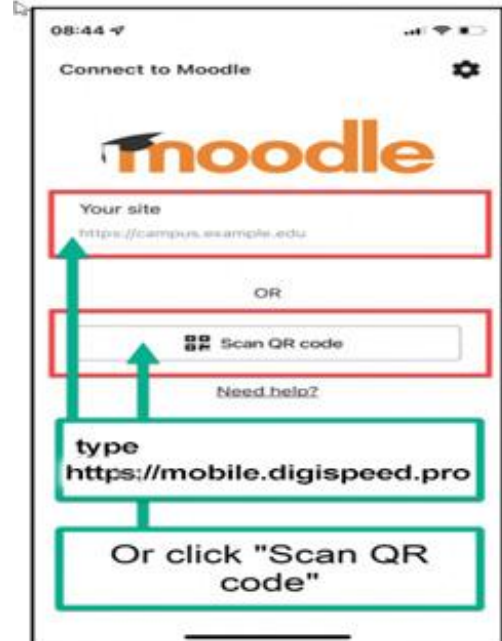
The activity plans are designed according to the following 11 conditions that cause learning difficulties. Each lesson also includes informative videos about the targeted learning disability.

- Dyslexia
- Dyscalculia
- Hearing Impairment
- Visual Impairment
- Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)
- Depression
- Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD)
- Intellectual Disability
- Anxiety Disorders
- Disruptive Behavior Disorders
- Expressive Language Disorder
